The bill concerns the sexual exploitation of a patient or former patient by a mental health services provider. It provides penalties for therapeutic deception including fines and the immediate revocation of the mental health providers' license.

Fiscal Analysis

The ENGR version of SB 657 establishes specific penalties/fines for certain crimes:

Crime	Penalty
Single act of therapeutic deception	Felony punishable by a fine of not
with one current or former patient	more than \$5,000 and immediate
	revocation of licensing.
Multiple acts of therapeutic deception	Felony punishable by a fine of not
with one current or former patient	more than \$10,000 and immediate
	revocation of licensing.
Multiple acts of therapeutic deception	Felony punishable by a fine of not
with two or more current or former	more than \$25,000 and immediate
patient	revocation of licensing.

Since these felonies are not eligible to be penalized by incarceration, there is no cost to the state.
