Research Analysis

SB 693 expands the definition of *building and construction inspector* to include an individual not employed by a political subdivision of the state, and removes employment status with a political subdivision from the definition of *inactive building and construction inspector*. The measure removes a requirement that an inspector be employed at the time of license renewal. Finally, the authorized *agent* inspector license is changed to authorized *provider* inspector license.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure pertains to expanding and cleaning up the language and providing definition for the Oklahoma Inspectors Act, widening the field by which applicants may be licensed. With the new language there is an anticipated positive impact, but will depend on the number of new and renewed application for licenses in varied state political subdivisions.
