**Research Analysis**

SB 697 provides that all rulemaking authority delegated by the Legislature to executive branch agencies shall be used only to implement law or policy as set by the Legislature. Within three years of the effective date of this act, all administrative rules, including those already in existence, must include a specific reference to the statutory provision that delegates the authority for promulgation of the rule
