Research Analysis

The bill directs the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to include behavioral health case managers that are employed by a tribe or tribal facility that provides behavioral health services and those that employed by an Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs or U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs facility in the rules and standards for certification. The bill directs the Department to do the same for peer recovery support specialists. Lastly, it removes 2-year history of addiction time limit placed on an opioid substitution treatment program.
