**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 748 allows, upon availability of funds, the Oklahoma Department of Human Services to create a pilot program that improves the socioeconomic outcomes for children by evaluating substance abuse of parents, mental health, disabilities and domestic abuse within households, and to implement and coordinate programs to address such factors. Currently, DHS is unable to estimate the cost of the program if implemented.
