Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to SB 770 increases the number of hours of training to be completed by reserve special agents of Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from a minimum of 160 hours to a minimum of 240 hours of training. The measure provides that any employee of the OBNDD in a classified position under the Merit System of the Personnel Administration who is appointed Director, Deputy Director, Acting Director or Acting Deputy Director has a right to return to the highest previously held classified position without any loss of rights, privileges or benefits immediately upon completion of the duties of the employee, provided the employee is not otherwise disqualified.

SB 770 places 3,4-dichloro-N[2-dimethylamino)cyclohexyl]-Nmethylbenzamide, a synthetic opiate as a Schedule 1 drug. The measure excludes Iolupane from Schedule II. Phenazepam, etizolam, and clonazolam are listed as substances having a potential for abuse.

The measure provides that the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control may designate noncommissioned personnel as compliance inspectors for the purpose of conducting inspections of controlled premises.
