**Research Analysis**

SB 770 places 3,4-dichloro-N[2-dimethylamino)cyclohexyl]-Nmethylbenzamide, a synthetic opiate as a Schedule 1 drug. The measure removes Iolupane from Schedule II. Phenazepam, etizolam, and clonazolam are listed as substances having a potential for abuse.
