Research Analysis

The bill clarifies the definition of *distribute or distribution* within the Oklahoma Pharmacy Act by adding the phrase “provided, taking actual physical possession of a product or title shall not be required.” Additionally, it modifies the definition of *manufacturer or virtual manufacturer* to include “a person who contracts with another to manufacture a product.”

It gives the State Board of Pharmacy the authority to approve certain pilot projects designed to utilize new or expanded technology or processes or provide services in a more safe and efficient manner. It exempts dialysate sold, dispensed or delivered in their original, sealed packaging upon receipt of prescriber’s order from the filled prescription label requirement. Lastly, it removes the Board from the State Employment Review Board.
