**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS version of SB 786 reduces minimum sentences for burglary in the first, second, and third degree which has the possibility of reducing the DOC incarceration rate. On average it costs DOC \$52.24 per day and \$19,067.60 per year to incarcerate an individual.
