Research Analysis

SB 80 authorizes the Department of Rehabilitation Services (DRS) to transfer monies between funds and provides that the agency's receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds will be exempt from spending limitations. Finally, the Director of DRS is authorized to request the early transfer of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for allocation to the agency's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 80 has no fiscal considerations to the state. The measure allows the Oklahoma Department of Rehabilitative Services to transfer appropriated and federal monies, Medical and Assistance Funds from current and prior years to and between disbursing funds to carry out duties. The measure exempts federal funds from expenditure limitations.
