**Research Analysis**

The CCS for SB 806 requires child care facilities to follow the Child and Adult Care Food Program; to limit sugar-sweetened beverages to one per day; to provide children with opportunities for physical activity each day; to engage with infants on the ground to optimize adult-infant interaction, and to eliminate screen time for children younger than 2 years.
