**Research Analysis**

The bill modifies the grade level whereby a student will be suspended for assaulting or attempting to cause bodily injury to an education employee or volunteer from grade six to grade three. Additionally, it requires students who are guilty of violating a school regulation, possessing an intoxicating beverage or low-point beer, or possession of missing or stolen property, to complete an intervention and prevention program as provided by designated Youth Service Agencies or when necessary a mental health provider contracted with the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.

**Fiscal Analysis**

ESB 81 modifies the grade level related to certain student discipline. Further, a school district will require a student guilty of certain acts to complete specified intervention and prevention programs, or when necessary a mental health provider contracted with the Department of Mental Health.
