**Research Analysis**

The CS for SB 819 specifies that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) is authorized to file a lien on the homestead of a Medicaid recipient for care received in an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID). The measure also specifies that the lien filed for care received in an ICF/IID or a nursing facility will be effective from the date the recipient entered the facility.
