Research Analysis

The PCS modifies probationary promotion under the Reading Sufficiency Act. For the 2016-17 and 2017-18 school years, students who score at the unsatisfactory level on the reading portion of the third grade statewide assessment may be evaluated for probationary promotion by the Student Reading Proficiency Team. Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, this will apply to students who score below the proficiency level. If the Legislature takes no action during the 1st Session of the 57th Legislature then probationary promotion by a Student Reading Proficiency Team will continue indefinitely. Lastly, it modifies the Reading Report Card by requiring it to be submitted to the Speaker of the House and President Pro Tempore of the Senate and adds additional information to the report card.
