SB 85 provides an exception from the provision that, for construction on the Interstate Highway System in a municipality with 5,000 or more and on which federal funds are used for removing or relocating utility facilities, the municipality would be required to match those federal funds. If the utility is owned by another municipality which has 5,000 or more population, the utility owner is to furnish the matching funds.
