**Research Analysis**

SB 872 provides that the requirement for issuance of certain bond obligations relating to construction of the American Indian Cultural Center will be deemed satisfied by the director of OMES that at least \$10 Million have been deposited in the American Indian Cultural Center and Museum Completion Fund. The measure also cleans up statutory and citation language.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure clarifies language that requires certification and authorization of any nonstate and nonfederal donations, contributions, and gifts given to the American Indian Cultural Center and Museum which exceeds Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) by the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES).
