**Research Analysis**

SB 90 increases the number of hours a reserve force deputy sheriff must undergo before being allowed to work unaccompanied from 160 hours to 240 hours. The measure also requires that the 240 hours of training be completed within 6 months of the deputy being commissioned. The measure also requires reserve special agents of OSBI receive 240 hours of training.
