Research Analysis

SB 900 clarifies the definition of *offender* in the Delayed Sentencing Program for Young Adults to include a person adjudicated as a juvenile delinquent or youthful offender. The measure also directs the Department of Corrections, upon an offender's completion of the program, to notify the Sheriff of the county originating the order. The bill further directs that Sheriff to take custody of the offender.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 900, which clarifies a definition, is determined to have some cost savings to the Dept. of Corrections (DOC). The measure deals with the parameters of the Delayed Sentencing Program- DOC expects cost savings related to shifting the responsibility for the transportation of the inmate from the agency to the sheriffs. The ultimate impact is contingent upon how many inmates are sent to the program and need transportation.
