Research Analysis

SB 922 directs the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to establish the Oklahoma Women Veterans Program. The program's mission is to ensure that women veterans have equitable access to federal and states veterans' benefits and services. The program is directed to provide assistance to women veterans, perform outreach functions, assess the needs of women veterans, review programs and other incentives designed to address the needs of women veterans, make recommendations to the executive director regarding improvement of benefits and services to women veterans, and incorporate issues concerning women veterans in Department planning. The program is also required to deliver a report biennially on women veterans in the state.
