## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 940, which adds certain forms of fentanyl and one other drug to the list of schedule I drugs, has no direct fiscal impact on the state. Adding these to the list, however, does increase the possibility of felony convictions and associated fines. The impact is contingent upon how many individuals are convicted, sentenced to incarceration, and/or directed to pay a fine. Currently it costs the State of Oklahoma, on average, \$58.70/day and \$21,425.50/year to incarcerate an individual in DOC custody.
