Research Analysis

The engrossed measure allows a student to receive tuition funds through the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP) if the student is a child of a certified classroom teacher. The student will not be considered in financial need if at the time the student applies for OHLAP, at the time the student begins postsecondary education and prior to receiving an OHLAP award the federal adjusted gross income of the student's parent(s) exceeds \$150,000. Employment status of the parent(s) must be verified prior to the student receiving an OHLAP award. This applies to students in the eighth, ninth, or tenth grade that are enrolled in a public or private school or students between the ages of thirteen and fifteen who are educated by other means who apply for OHLAP after the 2017-18 school year.

The following estimates assume current college persistence rates of students receiving the OKPromise benefit. OSRHE also assumes an annual increase of four percent in the average scholarship award levels.
