Research Analysis

The engrossed measure directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to examine the feasibility of a state plan amendment to the state Medicaid program for diabetes self-management training (DSMT). The Authority must submit a report to the Governor and Legislature by December 1, 2018, that estimates the costs to the state, clinical findings, reviews of pilot projects and research from other states on the effects of DSMT. Subject to the availability of funding, beginning July 1, 2019, the Authority must draft a state plan amendment for DSMT if the report shows it is evidence-based and essential to qualifying participants.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 972 has no fiscal implications to the state.
