SJR 66 sends to a vote of the people an amendment to the state constitution that, if approved, would provide for the joint nomination and election of candidates for Governor and Lieutenant Governor beginning with the General Election in 2026.

Fiscal Analysis

SJR 66 in its current form would sends to the vote of the people an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution that would require Governor and Lieutenant Governor candidates to run on the same ticket. The measure makes no change to either official's compensation, powers, or duties; therefore, the measure is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
