L 7	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified						
L 8	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 323 of Title 3, unless there is

- through use of an onboard computer, communication links and other additional equipment necessary to operate the aircraft and includes unmanned aircraft commonly called drones.
  - B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, a person shall not intentionally or knowingly operate an unmanned aircraft over the private agricultural property of another.
    - C. This section shall not apply to conduct committed by:
  - 1. The federal government, the state or a political subdivision of the state;
  - 2. A person under contract with or otherwise acting under the direction or on behalf of the federal government, the state or a political subdivision of the state;
  - 3. A law enforcement agency;

- 4. A person under contract with or otherwise acting under the direction or on behalf of a law enforcement agency;
- 5. A person who has the prior written consent of the property owner or legal tenant or lessee of the property;
- 6. A public utility or oil and gas company primarily engaged in commercial operations for the production, sale and distribution of electricity, oil or natural gas, or any person or persons under contract or at the direction or on behalf of the public utility or oil and gas company that have an existing easement or right-of-way and have notified the owner of the property. Prominently displaying or erecting a sign or language reasonably calculated to communicate

to the owner of the property the identity of the company and description of the activity during and in close proximity to the actual operation of the unmanned aircraft shall be deemed sufficient notice under this paragraph. Such notice shall not be required when the operation of the unmanned aircraft is being performed to assess the location of actual outage on any electric delivery infrastructure; or

- 7. An operator of an unmanned aircraft that is being used for a commercial purpose, provided that the operator is authorized by the Federal Aviation Administration to conduct the operation.
- D. Nothing in subsection C of this section shall purport to authorize conduct which would constitute an unreasonable search or seizure under the Fourth Amendment of the United States Constitution or Section 30 of Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution.
- E. Any violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
