CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state contracts; limiting amount
and duration of certain roofing contracts;
establishing criteria for contract eligibility;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.7j of Title 74, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning November 1, 2017, the Roof Asset Management
Program, also known as the RAMP program, shall be discontinued and a
new program, known as the Multi-Bidder Optional Roofing Program,
shall be established. Whenever the terms "Roof Asset Management
Program" or "RAMP", when used to reference the "Multi-Bidder

Optional Roofing Program", appear in statute or rule, such terms shall mean the Multi-Bidder Optional Roofing Program.

B. 1. Beginning November 1, 2017, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall preferably allow five or more contractors, but no less than three contractors, in the same region of the state to enter into contracts for roofing repairs or replacement through the Multi-Bidder Optional Roofing Program. If three bids do not meet bid requirements, there may be fewer than three contractors in a region.

2. Beginning November 1, 2017, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall allow project bids to be awarded to contractors in each region of the state for a period of one (1) year. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide winning bidders with the option to renew their contract for two (2) additional yearlong periods.

3. Beginning November 1, 2017, except for those contracts entered into before November 1, 2017, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall award project bids under the Multi-Bidder Option Roofing Program to prequalified contractors who:

a. submit the lowest responsible bid, and

b. submit all such items enumerated in this section by
the established deadline, to eliminate unqualified
bids.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
