11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and  
entire bill and insert

codification -

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.7j of Title 74, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Beginning January 1, 2018, the Roof Asset Management  
21 Program, also known as the RAMP program, or a successor program  
22 authorized by statute or agency rule, shall be known as the Oklahoma  
23 Optional Roofing Program. Whenever the terms "Roof Asset Management  
24 Program" or "RAMP", when used to reference the "Oklahoma Optional

1 Roofing Program", appear in statute or rule, such terms shall mean  
2 the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.

3 B. 1. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those  
4 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any  
5 contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf  
6 of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of  
7 Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting  
8 program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a  
9 successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that does  
10 not exceed a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be  
11 required to utilize the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.

12 2. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those  
13 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any  
14 contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf  
15 of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of  
16 Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting  
17 program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a  
18 successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that exceeds  
19 a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) may utilize the  
20 Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program or may adhere to the requirements  
21 of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974.

22 3. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those  
23 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the  
24 Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall collect a fee for

1 services provided by the Office under the Oklahoma Optional Roofing  
2 Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency  
3 rule, of no more than one percent (1%) of the roofing contract  
4 price.

5 4. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those  
6 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the  
7 Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall permit no more  
8 than six contractors, but no less than four contractors in the same  
9 region of the state to enter into contracts for roofing repairs or  
10 replacement through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program  
11 simultaneously.

12 ~~SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~  
13 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~  
14 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~  
15 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval."~~

16 Upon the effective date of this act, any contract for roofing  
17 repairs or replacement entered into on behalf of a state agency or  
18 political subdivision by the Office of Management and Enterprise  
19 Services utilizing an ongoing contracting program through the  
20 Roofing Asset Management Program (RAMP) or a successor program  
21 authorized by statute or agency rule shall not exceed a total of  
22 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

23 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
