CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund;  
making an appropriation; stating purpose; providing  
an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of  
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of  
Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may  
be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
