CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motor vehicle license plates; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 408 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to special license plates; creating the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate; authorizing personalized plates; providing for design of license plates; requiring certain portion of fees be deposited in certain fund; creating Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate; authorizing personalized plates for use on vehicles or motorcycles; providing for design of plate; requiring certain portion of funds be deposited in specified fund; creating the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund; placing fund with the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; providing for budget and expenditure procedures related to such fund; amending 3 O.S. 2011, Section 91, as amended by Section 21, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (3 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 91), which relates to the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund; authorizing deposit of certain fees from license plates; authorizing expenditure of funds for certain purpose; conforming language; repealing 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 2 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 14 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 565 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, which are duplicate

1 versions of a statute relating to license plates;
2 providing for codification; and providing an
3 effective date.
4

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
7 last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 408 of the 1st
8 Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
11 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
12 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
13 financial assistance as provided by this section.

14 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
15 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
16 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
17 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
18 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

19 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
20 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
21 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
22 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
23 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
24

1 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
2 issued on a staggered system.

3 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
4 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
5 applications for special license plates authorized under this
6 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
8 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
12 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
13 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

15 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
16 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
17 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
18 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
19 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
20 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
21 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
22 removed from the vehicle.

23 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
24 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax

1 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
2 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
3 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
4 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
5 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
6 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
7 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

8 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
9 follows:

10 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
13 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
14 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

15 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
16 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
19 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
20 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
21 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
23 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
24 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued

1 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
2 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
3 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
4 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
5 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
6 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

7 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
8 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

9 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
10 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
11 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
12 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
13 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
14 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
15 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
16 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
17 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
18 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
19 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
20 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
21 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

23 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &

1 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
2 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

3 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
5 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
7 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
8 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
9 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
10 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
11 plates.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
14 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
18 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
19 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
20 the prevention of child abuse.

21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

23 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
24 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
2 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
3 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
4 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
5 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
6 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
7 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
9 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
10 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
11 issued;

12 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
14 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
15 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
16 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

17 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
19 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
20 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
21 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
22 Oklahoma;

23 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of

1 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
2 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
3 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
4 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
5 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
8 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
9 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
11 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
13 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
14 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
15 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
16 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

17 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
19 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
20 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
21 Revolving Fund;

22 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
2 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
3 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
4 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
5 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
6 provide services to crime victims;

7 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
10 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
11 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
12 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
13 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
14 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

15 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
16 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
17 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
19 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
20 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
21 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
22 Section 1104.4 of this title;

23 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
24 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
2 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
3 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
4 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
5 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
6 Section 1104.3 of this title;

7 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
9 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
10 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
11 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
12 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
13 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
14 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
15 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
18 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
19 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
20 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
21 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
22 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
23 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
24 follows:

- a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education Reform Revolving Fund,
- b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher Education Revolving Fund,
- c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State Career Technology Fund, and
- d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this paragraph;

18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

1 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
2 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
3 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
4 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
5 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
6 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
7 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
8 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
9 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

10 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
12 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
13 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
14 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
15 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
16 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
17 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
18 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
19 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
20 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
21 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
24 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and

1 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
2 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
3 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
4 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
5 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
6 of this title;

7 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
10 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
11 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
12 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
13 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
14 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

15 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
16 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
17 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
18 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
19 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
20 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
21 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
23 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
24 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury

1 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
2 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
3 specifically for created families;

4 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
5 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
6 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
7 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
8 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
9 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
10 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
11 this title;

12 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
13 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
16 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
17 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
18 Section 1104.7 of this title;

19 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
21 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
23 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation

1 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
2 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
3 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
4 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
5 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
6 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

7 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
9 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
10 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
11 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
12 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
13 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
14 Section 1104.8 of this title;

15 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
16 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
18 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
19 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
20 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
21 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
22 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
23 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
24 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use

1 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
2 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
3 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
4 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
5 plate issued;

6 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
10 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
11 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
12 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
13 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
14 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
15 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
16 plate issued;

17 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
20 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
21 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

22 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
23 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
24 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The

American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.10 of this title;

32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

1 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
2 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
3 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
4 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
5 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
6 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
7 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
8 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
9 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
10 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
12 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
4 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
5 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
7 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

8 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
12 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
13 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
14 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
16 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

17 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
18 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
19 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
20 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
21 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
22 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
23 title;

1 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
2 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
3 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
4 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
5 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
8 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

9 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
12 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
13 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
14 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
15 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
16 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
17 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
18 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
19 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
20 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
21 each license plate issued;

22 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
24 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization

1 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
2 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
3 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
4 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
5 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
6 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
7 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall

19 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Friends of the
20 Capitol License Plate Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.18
21 of this title;

22 46. Eastern Red Cedar Tree License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
24 Commission and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

1 for the removal of Eastern Red Cedar trees from lands in the state
2 and to develop marketable uses for the harvested trees. The license
3 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Eastern Red Cedar
4 Registry Board. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected
5 shall be deposited in the Eastern Red Cedar Revolving Fund created
6 in Section 18-407 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The money
7 shall be designated for and may only be expended for the purposes as

14 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
15 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.
16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
18 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

19 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
20 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
21 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
22 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
23 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
24 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research

1 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
2 title;

3 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
4 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
5 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
6 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

8 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
9 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in
10 Section 1104.21 of this title;

11 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
12 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
13 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
14 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
16 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited in the Juvenile Diabetes Research
18 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.22 of this
19 title;

20 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
21 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
22 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Deer Creek Schools Foundation.
24 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

1 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
2 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount
3 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Deer Creek Schools
4 Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.23
5 of this title;

6 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
7 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
8 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
10 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
11 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
12 in Section 1104.24 of this title. Subject to the provisions of
13 subsection A of this section, the Lupus Awareness and Education
14 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

15 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
16 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
17 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for a vehicle or motorcycle
18 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
19 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall be
20 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of
21 Police. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design
22 as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
23 requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The Tax Commission
24 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the

Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the association's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Chiefs of Police License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

23 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

2 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
3 Oklahoma Children's Cancer Association. The license plates shall be
4 designed in consultation with the administration of the Oklahoma
5 Children's Cancer Association. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
6 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
7 Children's Cancer Association for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the Oklahoma Children's Cancer
9 Association's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
10 for a payment to the Oklahoma Children's Cancer Association of not
11 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 Authority. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited in the Educational Television Authority
18 Revolving Fund created in Section 156 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
19 Statutes;

20 60. Remembering Fallen Heroes License Plate - such plates shall
21 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
22 for Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. Such plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapter of Concerns of
24 Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section, an amount of

1 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Concerns of
2 Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
3 1104.27 of this title;

4 61. Owasso Rams Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the Owasso Rams, and shall be designed in consultation with
7 representatives of Owasso Schools. The plates shall be issued to
8 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
9 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
10 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
11 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
12 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 62. Collinsville Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
15 demonstrate support for the Collinsville Cardinals, and shall be
16 designed in consultation with representatives of Collinsville
17 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
19 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
20 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
21 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
22 Oklahoma Statutes;

23 63. Sperry Pirates Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
24 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

1 for the Sperry Pirates, and shall be designed in consultation with
2 representatives of Sperry Schools. The plates shall be issued to
3 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
4 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
5 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
6 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
7 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 64. Skiatook Bulldogs Supporter License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for the Skiatook Bulldogs, and shall be designed in
11 consultation with representatives of Skiatook Schools. The plates
12 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
13 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
14 plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in
16 Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

17 65. Rejoice Christian Eagles Supporter License Plate - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the Rejoice Christian Eagles, and shall be
20 designed in consultation with representatives of Rejoice Christian
21 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
23 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
24 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education

1 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes;

3 66. East Central Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the East Central Cardinals, and shall be
6 designed in consultation with representatives of East Central
7 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
8 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
9 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
10 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education

19 license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

22 68. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness

1 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
3 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
4 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
5 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
6 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
7 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

8 69. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
9 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
10 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
11 provide financial support for current veterans and shall be for a
12 vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of numbers and letters from
13 one to seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall
14 be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. The
15 license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design as space
16 permits or a new design in order to meet the space requirement of a
17 motorcycle license plate. As provided in this section, an amount of
18 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Prisoner of War and
19 Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 2
20 of this act.

21 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
22 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
23 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
24 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

1 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
2 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
3 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
4 license plate;

5 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
7 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

9 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
10 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

11 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.28 of Title 47, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
15 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Prisoner of War
16 and Missing in Action License Plate shall be deposited in the
17 Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund
18 created in subsection B of this section.

19 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
20 fund for the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to be
21 designated the "Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
22 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
23 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
24 by the Department pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this

1 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for
3 any purpose related to Oklahoma residents who are American veterans.
4 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
5 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
6 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
7 approval and payment.

8 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 3 O.S. 2011, Section 91, as
9 amended by Section 21, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (3 O.S. Supp. 2016,
10 Section 91), is amended to read as follows:

11 Section 91. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
12 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission to be
13 designated as the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund.
14 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
15 limitations, and shall consist of a monthly allocation by the
16 Oklahoma Tax Commission of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) from
17 the motor fuel excise tax levied and collected pursuant to the
18 provisions of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, such amount being a
19 part of the estimated amount of tax paid on gasoline consumed by
20 engines to propel aircraft in Oklahoma, sale of surplus property,
21 fees and receipts collected pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records
22 Act, donations, gifts, bequests, ~~contribution~~ contributions,
23 devices, interagency reimbursements, federal funds unless otherwise
24 provided by federal law or regulation, sale of leases and aircraft

1 registration fees and taxes, fees authorized by Section 1135.5 of
2 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes or any other source. All monies
3 accruing to ~~said~~ the fund are hereby appropriated and may be
4 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission for
5 airport construction and rehabilitation programs ~~and,~~ general
6 operations of the agency, for promoting the awareness of aviation
7 and aerospace, and providing financial support for aviation
8 education programs to address the need for a skilled and competent
9 aviation workforce. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made
10 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
11 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
12 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

13 SECTION 4. REPEALER 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
14 last amended by Section 2 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 14 of the 1st
15 Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and Section 1 of Enrolled
16 Senate Bill No. 565 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma
17 Legislature, are hereby repealed.

18 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
