CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to district attorneys; amending 19  
O.S. 2011, Section 215.39, which relates to narrative  
reports; expanding exception to requirement for  
narrative reports; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 215.39, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 215.39. A. Upon the arrest, conviction and sentencing  
of any defendant to the custody of the Department of Corrections,  
the district attorney of the county in which the crime was committed  
shall prepare a written narrative report describing the commission  
of the offense and any factors which might enhance or diminish the  
gravity of the offender's conduct.

B. The report shall be provided to the Department of  
Corrections and the Pardon and Parole Board, together with the

1 judgment and sentence in the case and any victim impact statements  
2 presented to the court in the case.

3 C. The form to be used for this report shall be developed and  
4 distributed by the District Attorneys Council.

5 D. The provisions of this section shall not apply to offenders  
6 sentenced to terms of incarceration of ~~two (2)~~ five (5) years or  
7 less.

8 E. No allegations or recitations of alleged facts contained in  
9 any narrative submitted pursuant to the requirements of this section  
10 shall give rise to any cause of action by the defendant against the  
11 submitting agency unless the defendant shall first object to such  
12 allegation or recitation in writing, with notice to the submitting  
13 agency. The submitting agency shall be given thirty (30) days  
14 following such notice to withdraw or amend any such allegation or  
15 recitation objected to. Nothing contained herein shall be construed  
16 as creating a cause of action.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
