




CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to size, weight and load; exempting certain agricultural vehicles from certain requirements; defining certain term; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-124 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Agricultural motor vehicles engaged in intrastate commerce shall be exempt from the requirement for electronic logging devices and hours of services as mandated by Section 32301(b) of the U.S. Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Enhancement Act.

B. For the purposes of this section, agricultural vehicles shall include, but are not limited to, single axel trucks with a

1 gooseneck or bumper pull trailer for the purpose of hauling horses
2 or livestock, and trailers with living quarters.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
