HB 1018xx in a new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes proposes to prohibit the Oklahoma Tax Commission from selling cigarette excise tax stamps to any wholesaler in excess of the amount of the monthly average amount of such excise tax stamps sold to such wholesaler during the preceding calendar year unless the wholesaler can document to the satisfaction of the Tax Commission probable sales greater than those in the preceding calendar year.
