Bill Summary and Comments: HB 2630 modifies the eligibility requirements for the electronic monitoring program for nonviolent offenders. Expanding the GPS program will help DOC save on cost for monitoring inmates. Currently, the average cost for an inmate who is being tracked on GPS Monitoring is \$3.34 per day. The minimum cost for an inmate within DOC custody is \$47.69 per day. Based on this data, DOC will be saving a minimum of \$44.35 per day per inmate. The Pardon & Parole Board could see a possible increase in cost due to increased caseload amounts. The exact amount of savings for DOC and the cost for PPB is contingent upon how many individuals are eligible and will participate in the program.
