Bill Summary and Comments:

HB 2702 establishes a fine for littering objects in excess of 50lbs. The fiscal impact will be contingent upon how many individuals are convicted with the fine and how much they are mandated to pay. This bill also increases the maximum fine for traffic citations for dumping from \$400 to \$500 and provides that if the citation was issued by a peace officer of a county, the funds that would otherwise be paid into the littering reward program are to be transferred to the general fund of the county of the law enforcement officer issuing the citation.
