Bill Summary and Comments: HB 2796 requires manufacturers and distributors who are required to register with the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control make available all data required pursuant to federal law, federal rules and regulations and Section 827 of Title 21 of the United States Code.
HB 2796 upon review by OBNDD is determined to have some cost associated with implementation. According to the agency, “additional resources would be necessary to include manpower and a database system to track the information.” The revenue from a sister bill (HB 2795) is intended to fund this measure, although OBNDD estimates the cost might exceed the \$90,000 anticipated revenue from HB 2795.
