Bill Summary and Comments: HB 3147 establishes misdemeanors and felonies for motorists regarding several cyclist passing incidences. The exact fiscal impact for the state is contingent upon how many individuals are convicted of the crime and the amount of the fine they are mandated to pay. Regarding the felony charge, the impact is contingent upon how many individuals are incarcerated in DOC custody. Currently the average cost of incarceration in Oklahoma is \$52.90/day or \$19,309.70/year.
