**Bill Summary and Comments:** This bill would allow a high school student who meets the eligibility requirement for concurrent or dual enrollment to participate in a program offered by any institution, regardless of location. It also allows a school district that offers early college/concurrent/dual enrollment to partner with any institution, regardless of location.

It is difficult to put a specific amount on this but there are potential issues that could impact costs for higher ed institutions:

1. if service areas are removed, it could cost universities more to deliver concurrent than a community college, regardless of distance to the high school;
2. it could cost an institution outside the service area more to deliver concurrent courses than an institution within the current service area;
