Bill Summary and Comments:

According the the Administrator of the Courts, if current citation trends remain constant, the lowering of fines and fees for speeding violations would decrease funding for several agencies who receive revenue from these citations.

If the same amount of speeding tickets were distributed in future years as were distributed in 2017, there would be an estimated \$2,090,000 less revenue generated due to the lowering of fees and fines. This would result in funding decreases to the District Courts, local Courts, and several other state agencies. The rate of citations being given would need to roughly double from current trends to maintain recent funding estimates.
