Bill Summary and Comments:

SB 1430 states that no person may attempt to perform or intentionally perform an abortion for the solely because the unborn child has been diagnosed either with Down syndrome/genetic abnormality or a potential for Dow syndrome/abnormality. The physician who violates this will be guilty of a misdemeanor and a fine of no less than \$10,000 as well as suspension or revocation of the medical license. SB 1430 also lists the steps to be made for lawsuits against the physicians who

violate this act.
