## Bill Summary and Comments:

This bill would restrict OHLAP awards from being used for remedial courses. The \$55,000 AGI income limit would apply to students entering college as first time freshmen in 2020-2021. The \$60,000 AGI income limit would apply to students entering college as first time freshmen in 2024-2025. The cap on the total number of credit hours paid by OKPromise would apply to college freshment entering in 2018-2019; the fiscal savings for this change is expected in 2022-23. The cumulative change from 2018-2019 compared to current

projections is a decrease of \$2,300,000.
