**Bill Summary and Comments:** This bill allows the Governor to designate an agency as an enterprise agency for five years. The purpose of designating an enterprise agency is to grant the agency relief from certain statutory provisions or agency rules upon a prior showing of projected savings or increased efficiency resulting from such relief. An annual performance agreement is required which will be submitted to the Legislature. Some of the statutory requirements an enterprise agency would be exempt from include the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act, the Public Competitive Bidding Act, and the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act. An enterprise agency may also temporarily waive or suspend the provisions of any administrative rule under certain circumstances and with the Governor's approval. An annual report is also required.
