Bill Summary and Comments:

This bill directs the Regents, in cooperation with the State Board to Education, to encourage eligible students to participate in concurrent enrollment on high school campuss, on college and university campuses and via online courses. It would expand eligibility to juniors in high school and allow eligible students to take a maximum of 9 credit hours in their junior year and and maximum of 18 credit hours in their senior year of high school. This bill also requires the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to issue an annual report on the concurrent enrollment program by December 1 of each year and specifies the information to be included.
