## *Bill Summary and Fiscal Impact*

**Bill Summary and Comments:** This bill adds levels of larceny to current statute with additional levels of punishment for each. SB 928 also allows all larcenies performed within 30 days of each other by an individual or group of individuals to be compiled in order to estimate the total value of the larcenies and determine the level of punishment for the crimes.

With this measure is a potential for an increase in felony cases, which could lead to an increase in overall DOC inmate population. However, the majority of larceny crimes are valued below \$15,000 and this bill lowers the incarceration period for larcenies below this value, which could result in a gradual decrease in DOC inmate population of lower level offenders.
