Bill Summary and Comments:

This bill would allow the State Board of Education to accept teaching experience from out-of-country schools when that person was a member of the Peace Corps and the out-of-country school is accredited or otherwise endorsed by the appropriate national or regional accrediting authority.

Currently the Board may accept up to 5 years of out of country teaching experience. This does not change.

Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System does not anticipate any impact.
