Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1172 creates an optional defined contribution plan for OTRS participants who joined the system on or after July 1, 2018. The participant minimum deferral would be 4.5% of compensation. The employer match would be 6% of compensation. If the employee elects to defer more than 7% of compensation, the employer match would not exceed 7% of compensation. K12, State Department of Career & Technology Education, OU and OSU are excluded.

Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1172 is a non fiscal bill as defined by the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Analysis Act because the amendment does not contain a benefit increase nor create liability.
