HOUSE BILL 3484

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; requiring certain individual to attend parenting class prior to receiving certain benefits; requiring Oklahoma Health Care Authority to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.14 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Before a child under the age of nineteen (19) years of age is eligible to receive Medicaid benefits, a parent of such child shall be required to attend a parenting class.

B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall be required to promulgate rules to create and establish the class set forth in subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
