18 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Delete the title, enacting clause and entire bill
19 and replace with:

20 "An Act relating to special license plates; amending
21 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by
22 Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
23 2018, Section 1135.2), which relates to special
24 license plates; deleting certain license plate;
modifying certain license plates for use on
motorcycles; creating the Combat Action Badge
Recipient license plate; creating the Iraq Combat
Veteran license plate; creating the Afghanistan

1 Combat Veteran license plate; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
2 Section 1135.3, as last amended by Section 24 of
3 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1041 of the 1st Session of
4 the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to
5 special license plates; reauthorizing Oklahoma
6 Aquarium license plate; demonstrating support;
7 deleting certain license plate; creating plate in
8 support of Toastmasters International; creating
9 plate in support of the Millwood High School Alumni;
10 creating plate in support of the Patriot Guard
11 Riders; creating plate in support of the Bixby
12 School District; providing for design consultation;
13 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last

15 1041 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma
16 Legislature, which relates to special plates;
17 allowing Folds of Honor Supporter license plate for
18 motorcycles; reauthorizing the Folds of Honor
19 Supporter license plate; reauthorizing the Sooner
20 State ABATE license plate; creating the Monarch
21 Butterfly license plate; creating the Oklahoma
22 Tennis Foundation license plate; creating the
23 Veterans of Foreign Wars license plate; creating the
24 Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization license plate;
creating the FIRST license plate; creating the
Pittsburg State University license plate; creating
the Historic Greenwood District license plate;
providing for design consultation; updating
statutory reference; creating the Monarch Butterfly
License Plate Revolving Fund and providing for
deposit of specified funds thereto; providing for
purpose of, and expenditures from, the Monarch
Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund; creating
Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth Festival
Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
3 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
4 provided by this section.

5 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
6 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
7 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
8 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
9 registered for the current year.

10 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
11 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
12 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
13 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
14 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
15 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
16 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
17 amateur radio operator license plates.

18 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
19 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
20 applications for special license plates authorized under this
21 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
22 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
23 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
24 information directly into such system and generate a receipt

1 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
2 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
3 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
4 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
5 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

6 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
7 follows:

8 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
10 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
11 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
12 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
13 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
14 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
15 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
16 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
17 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
18 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
19 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

23 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National

1 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
2 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
3 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
6 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
7 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
8 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
11 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
12 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
13 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
14 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
15 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
16 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
17 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
18 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form
19 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
20 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
21 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

22 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
24 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply

1 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

4 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
6 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
7 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
8 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
9 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
10 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
11 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
12 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
13 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
14 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
15 of one (1) ton or less;

16 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
18 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
19 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
20 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
21 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
22 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
23 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
24 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not

1 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
2 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
3 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
4 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
5 provided by this section for special license plates;

6 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
8 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
9 the United States as being:

10 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
11 7, 1941,

12 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
13 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
14 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
15 exceed three (3) miles, and

16 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
17 States Armed Forces.

18 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
19 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less;

21 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
22 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
23 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
24 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February of 1945,
- b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6, 1944,

- 1 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
2 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
3 participation cannot be verified by the United States
4 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
5 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
6 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
7 the person applying for the license plate, and
8 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
9 States Armed Forces.

10 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
11 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
14 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
15 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
16 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
17 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
18 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
19 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
20 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
21 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
22 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
23 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
24

1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
5 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
6 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
7 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
8 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
9 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
10 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
11 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
12 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
13 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
14 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

15 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
17 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
18 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
19 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
20 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such

1 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
5 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
6 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
7 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
8 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
9 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
11 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
12 education police department by either an identification card or
13 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
14 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
15 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
16 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
17 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
19 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
20 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
21 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

22 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
4 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
5 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
6 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
11 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
12 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
13 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
14 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
15 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
16 "WORLD WAR II";

17 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
19 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
20 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
21 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
22 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
23 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
24

1 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
2 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
7 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
8 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
9 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
10 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
11 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

12 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
14 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
15 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
16 be produced upon application;

17 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
19 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
20 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
21 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
22 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
23 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
24 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and

1 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
2 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
3 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
4 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
5 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
6 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

7 ~~20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall~~
8 ~~be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any~~
9 ~~resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars~~
10 ~~organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of~~
11 ~~Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans~~
12 ~~of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed~~
13 ~~in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;~~

14 ~~21.~~ Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
16 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
17 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
18 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
19 of one (1) ton or less;

20 ~~22.~~ 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
22 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such
23 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each
24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1 ~~23.~~ 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License
2 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or
3 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
4 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

5 ~~24.~~ 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
7 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
8 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
9 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
10 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

11 ~~25.~~ 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons
13 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the
14 Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Ninety-Nines;

16 ~~26.~~ 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman
18 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the
19 legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers.
20 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat
21 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman
22 Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
23 of one (1) ton or less;

1 ~~27.~~ 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
3 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the
4 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia
5 Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 ~~28.~~ 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
9 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
10 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
11 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

12 ~~29.~~ 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
14 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
15 United States Secretary of Defense;

16 ~~30.~~ 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
18 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
19 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
20 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
21 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 ~~31.~~ 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall

1 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator
2 serves and the district number;

3 ~~32.~~ 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
5 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
6 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
7 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
8 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
9 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
10 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
11 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
12 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
13 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
14 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
15 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
17 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
18 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
19 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
20 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
21 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
23 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
24 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other

1 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
2 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
3 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

4 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
5 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
6 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
7 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
8 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
9 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
10 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
11 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
12 the Tax Commission;

13 ~~33.~~ 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates -
14 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air
15 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must
16 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

18 ~~34.~~ 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
20 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
21 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
22 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
23 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
24

1 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
2 Academy;

3 ~~35.~~ 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid
5 operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the
6 Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a
7 motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
8 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
9 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
10 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
11 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
12 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
13 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
14 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
15 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
16 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
17 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
18 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
19 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
20 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
21 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
22 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
23 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall

5 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
6 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
7 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
8 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
9 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
10 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

11 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
13 applications for special license plates authorized under this
14 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
15 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
16 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
18 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
19 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
20 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
21 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

23 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
24 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,

1 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
2 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
3 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
4 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
5 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
6 removed from the vehicle.

7 Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates
8 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall
9 be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission
10 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The
11 prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within
12 one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the
13 authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In
14 the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by
15 the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so
16 received shall be refunded accordingly.

9 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
10 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
11 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
12 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
13 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

14 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
16 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
17 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

19 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
20 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
21 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
23 Columbus emblem;

1 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
2 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
3 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

5 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
7 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
8 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with Kiwanis International;

10 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
12 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
13 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
15 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
16 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public

6 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
7 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
8 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
9 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

10 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
11 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
12 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
13 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
14 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
15 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
16 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
17 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

18 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
19 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
20 applications for special license plates authorized under this
21 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
22 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
23 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
24 information directly into such system and generate a receipt

1 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
2 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
3 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
4 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
5 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

6 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
7 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
8 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
9 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
10 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
11 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
12 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
13 removed from the vehicle.

14 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
15 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
16 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
17 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
18 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
19 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
20 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
21 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
22 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

17 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
18 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
19 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
20 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
21 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

22 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
23 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
24 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four

1 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
2 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
3 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
4 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
5 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
6 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
7 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
8 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
10 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
11 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
12 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
16 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
17 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

18 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
21 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
22 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
23 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
24 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may

1 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
2 plates.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of

11 the prevention of child abuse.

17 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
19 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
20 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
23 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
24 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
2 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
3 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
4 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
5 follows:

- 6 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
7 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 8 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
9 Education Revolving Fund,
- 10 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
11 Career Technology Fund, and
- 12 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
13 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
14 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
15 Oklahoma Statutes.

16 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
17 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
18 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
19 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
20 paragraph;

21 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
22 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
23 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
24 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the

1 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
2 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
3 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
4 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
5 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

6 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
7 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
8 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
9 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
10 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
11 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
12 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
13 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
14 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

15 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
18 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
19 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
20 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
21 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
22 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
23 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
24 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment

1 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
2 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
6 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
7 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
8 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
10 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
11 of this title;

12 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
16 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
18 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
19 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

20 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
21 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
22 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
23 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
24 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of

1 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
2 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
3 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
4 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
5 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
6 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
7 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
8 created families;

9 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
11 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
12 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
13 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
14 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
15 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
16 this title;

17 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
22 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
23 Section 1104.7 of this title;

1 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
3 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
5 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
7 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
8 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
9 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
10 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
12 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

13 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
16 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
17 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
18 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
19 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
20 Section 1104.8 of this title;

21 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
22 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
24 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person

1 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
2 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
3 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
4 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
5 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
6 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
7 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
8 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
9 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
10 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
16 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
17 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
18 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
19 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
20 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
21 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
24 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic

1 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
2 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

3 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
5 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
6 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
7 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
8 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
9 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
10 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

11 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
13 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
14 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
16 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
17 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
18 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
20 Section 1104.10 of this title;

21 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
23 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
24 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active

1 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
2 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
3 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
4 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
5 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

6 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
7 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
8 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
9 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
10 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
11 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
12 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
13 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
14 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
15 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
19 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
20 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
21 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
22 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
23 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
24 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the

1 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
2 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
3 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
4 plate issued;

5 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
7 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed
8 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As
9 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in
11 Section 1104.12 of this title;

12 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
13 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
14 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
15 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
16 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
17 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
18 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
19 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
20 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

21 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
23 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
24 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,

1 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
2 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
3 title;

4 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
5 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
6 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
7 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
8 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
11 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

12 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
15 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
16 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
17 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
18 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
19 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
20 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
21 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
24 each license plate issued;

1 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
2 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor
4 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from
5 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26
6 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to
7 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military
8 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
9 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
10 Such person may apply for a Folds of Honor Supporter license plate
11 for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be
12 of similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be
13 a new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
14 license plate. The plate shall be designed in consultation with the
15 Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor Incorporated and shall
16 contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which includes
17 the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax

21 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
22 Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each
23 license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of

1 this section, the Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate is hereby
2 reauthorized effective November 1, ~~2018~~ 2019;

3 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
6 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
7 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
8 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
10 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
11 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
12 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
13 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
14 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers
16 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
17 license plate;

18 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
20 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
21 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
22 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
23 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
24 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this

1 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
2 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title

4 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
5 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and

16 shall be designated for and may only be expended for the purposes as

18 47. Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate - such plates
19 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
20 for the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer
21 Research Fund. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
23 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
24 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
3 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

4 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
5 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
6 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
8 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
10 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
11 title;

12 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
14 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

16 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
17 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
19 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
20 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
21 in Section 1104.24 of this title. Subject to the provisions of
22 subsection A of this section, the Lupus Awareness and Education
23 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2018;

1 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
2 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
3 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for a vehicle or motorcycle
4 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
5 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of
7 Police. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design
8 as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
9 requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The Tax Commission
10 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
11 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees
12 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
14 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police of not more than Twenty
15 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the
16 provisions of subsection A of this section, the Chiefs of Police
17 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

18 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.
21 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
22 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
23 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with
24 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be

1 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
2 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
3 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
4 plate issued;

5 55. Hilldale Education Foundation License Plate - such plates

22 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
23 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
24 Registration Act; and

1 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
2 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

3 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.33 of Title 47, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
7 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Monarch Butterfly
8 license plates shall be deposited to the Monarch Butterfly License
9 Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

10 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
11 fund for the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to be designated the
12 "Monarch Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall
13 consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of this
14 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
15 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
16 Conservation Commission for grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of the
17 Nature Conservancy to fund the Conservancy's operations in this
18 state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
19 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
20 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
21 Services for approval and payment.

22 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.32 of Title 68, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
2 to be designated the "Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth
3 Festival Revolving Fund" and administered by the Oklahoma Department
4 of Commerce. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to
5 fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all the monies
6 received by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to the
7 provisions related to the Historic Greenwood District License Plate
8 in Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies
9 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated and may be
10 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce at the
11 beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to
12 support and promote the Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth
13 Festival in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
14 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
15 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
16 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
17 approval and payment and in consultation with the Black Wall Street
18 Chamber of Commerce.

19 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019."

4 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
5 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
6 2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

7 Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
8 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
9 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
10 provided by this section.

11 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
12 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
13 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
14 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
15 registered for the current year.

16 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
17 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
18 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
19 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
20 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
21 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
22 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
23 amateur radio operator license plates.
24

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

24 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war

1 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
3 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
4 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
5 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

6 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
8 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
9 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
10 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

11 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
13 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
14 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
15 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
17 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
18 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
19 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
20 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
21 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
22 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
23 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
24 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or

1 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
2 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
3 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
4 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
6 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
7 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
8 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

10 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

11 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
13 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
14 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
16 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
17 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
18 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
19 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
20 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
21 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
22 of one (1) ton or less;

23 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper

1 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
2 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
3 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
4 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
5 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
6 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
7 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
8 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
9 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
10 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
11 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
12 provided by this section for special license plates;

13 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
15 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
16 the United States as being:

- 17 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
18 7, 1941,
- 19 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
20 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
21 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
22 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 23 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
24 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
3 less;

4 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
7 States as being:

- 8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
9 of 1945,
- 10 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
11 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall

18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."

9 participation cannot be verified by the United States

13 the person applying for the license plate, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United

22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
24 was killed in action and that the person making the application is

2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special

8 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be

10 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
11 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
12 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
13 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

14 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
15 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
16 applications for special license plates authorized under this
17 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
18 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
19 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
20 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
21 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
22 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
23 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
24

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates
12 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall
13 be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission
14 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The
15 prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within
16 one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the
17 authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In
18 the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by
19 the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so
20 received shall be refunded accordingly.

20 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
21 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates
22 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
23 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

1 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
4 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
5 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

6 39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support for the United States Air Force Academy;

9 40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
11 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

12 41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
13 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
14 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
16 Weather Center Directors;

17 42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for

23 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to

1 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South

3 44. Putnam City High School License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School Alumni
7 Association, Inc.;

8 45. Autism Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
10 autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
11 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

13 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
14 for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall be

17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of

21 Incorporated;

22 48. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

1 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
2 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions
3 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School
4 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

5 49. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
7 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be
8 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
9 School Alumni Association;

10 50. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
12 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
13 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with
14 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
15 Association;

16 51. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
17 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music

23 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

1 57. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
4 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
5 Arts;

6 58. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
10 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
11 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

12 59. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

16 60. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
19 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

20 61. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
21 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
22 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
23 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

1 62. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

5 63. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
6 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
7 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
8 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
9 District;

10 64. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
11 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
12 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
14 Alumni Association;

15 65. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
18 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
19 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

20 66. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
23 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
24 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall

1 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
2 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject
3 to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma
4 Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective
5 November 1, 2015;

6 67. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
7 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
8 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
9 Tulsa 66ers Organization;

10 68. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
11 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
12 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
13 representatives of the Frederick School District;

14 69. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
15 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
16 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current
17 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
18 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

19 70. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be
20 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
21 Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the
22 Oklahoma Fosters Initiative;

23 71. Red Dirt Jeeps - such plates shall be designed and issued
24 to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Red Dirt Jeeps and

1 such plates shall be designed in consultation with Red Dirt Jeeps,
2 L.L.C.; ~~and~~

3 72. Southeast Spartans Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 Southeast Spartans High School and such plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association;

7 73. Toastmasters International License Plate - such plates
8 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
9 Toastmasters International and shall be designed in consultation
10 with District 16 of Toastmasters International;

11 74. Millwood High School Alumni License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support for Millwood High School Alumni. The license plate shall be
14 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood High
15 School Alumni Association;

16 75. Patriot Guard Riders License Plate - such plates shall be
17 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for Patriot Guard
18 Riders and shall be designed in consultation with the Patriot Guard
19 Riders of Oklahoma; and

20 76. Bixby School District License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
22 the Bixby School District. The license plate shall be designed in
23 consultation with representatives of the Bixby School District.
24

1 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
2 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
3 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
4 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
5 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
6 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
7 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
8 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
9 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the
10 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
11 Section 1104 of this title.

12 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
13 last amended by Section 15, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp.
14 2018, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
16 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
17 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
18 financial assistance as provided by this section.

19 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
20 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
21 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
22 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
23 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.
24

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
7 issued on a staggered system.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
21 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
22 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
23 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
24 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license

1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
2 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
3 removed from the vehicle.

4 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
5 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
6 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
7 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
8 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
9 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
10 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
11 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
12 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

13 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
14 follows:

15 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

20 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
22 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
24 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide

1 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
2 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
3 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
4 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
5 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
6 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
7 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
8 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
9 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
10 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
11 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

12 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
13 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
14 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
15 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
16 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
17 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
18 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
19 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
20 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
21 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
22 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
23 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
24 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire

1 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
2 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

4 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
5 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
6 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
7 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

8 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
10 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
12 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
13 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
14 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
15 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
16 plates.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
19 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
22 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
23 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
24

1 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
2 the prevention of child abuse.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

5 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
6 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
8 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
9 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
10 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
11 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
12 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
13 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
14 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
16 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
17 issued;

18 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
20 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
22 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

23 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:
24

1 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
2 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
5 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
6 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
7 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

8 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
9 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
11 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
12 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
13 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
14 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
16 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
17 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
18 issued;

19 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
21 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
22 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
23 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
24

1 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
2 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
5 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
6 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
8 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
10 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
12 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
13 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
16 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
17 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
18 Revolving Fund;

19 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
22 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
23 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for

1 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
2 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
3 provide services to crime victims;

4 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
7 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
10 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
11 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

12 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
13 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
14 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
16 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
17 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
18 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
19 Section 1104.4 of this title;

20 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
22 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
24 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the

1 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
2 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
3 1104.3 of this title;

4 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
6 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
7 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
11 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
12 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
16 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
18 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
19 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
20 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
21 follows:

- 22 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
23 Reform Revolving Fund,
24

- 1 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
2 Education Revolving Fund,
3 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
4 Career Technology Fund, and
5 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
6 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
7 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
8 Oklahoma Statutes.

9 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
10 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
11 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
12 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
13 paragraph;

14 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
15 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
16 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
17 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
18 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
19 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
20 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
21 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
22 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
23 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
24 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any

5 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
6 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
7 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

8 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
11 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
12 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
13 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
14 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
15 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
16 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
17 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
18 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
19 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
22 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
23 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
24 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and

1 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
2 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
3 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
4 of this title;

5 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
9 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
10 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
11 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
12 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

13 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
14 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
15 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
16 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
17 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
18 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
19 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
20 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
21 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
22 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
23 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
24

1 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
2 created families;

3 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
4 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
5 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
6 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
7 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
8 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
9 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
10 this title;

11 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
13 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
14 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
15 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
16 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
17 Section 1104.7 of this title;

18 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
19 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
20 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
22 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
24 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association

1 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
2 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
3 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
4 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
5 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

6 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
8 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
9 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
10 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
11 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
12 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
13 Section 1104.8 of this title;

14 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
15 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
16 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
17 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
18 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
19 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
20 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
21 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
22 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
23 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
24 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The

1 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
2 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
3 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
4 plate issued;

5 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
8 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
9 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
10 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
11 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
12 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
13 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
14 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
17 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
18 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
19 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

20 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
21 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
22 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
23 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
24 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be

1 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
2 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
3 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

4 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
7 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
9 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
10 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
11 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
12 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
13 Section 1104.10 of this title;

14 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
16 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
17 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
18 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
19 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
20 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
21 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
22 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

23 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma

1 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
2 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
3 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
4 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
5 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
6 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
7 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
8 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
10 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
12 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
13 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
14 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
15 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
16 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
17 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
18 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
19 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
20 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
21 plate issued;

22 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed

1 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As
2 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
3 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in
4 Section 1104.12 of this title;

5 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
7 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
9 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
10 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
11 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
12 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
13 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

14 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
16 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
18 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
19 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
20 title;

21 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
22 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
23 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
24 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be

1 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
2 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
3 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
4 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

5 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
8 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
9 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
10 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
11 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
12 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
13 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
14 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
16 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
17 each license plate issued;

18 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
20 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
21 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
22 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
23 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
24 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in

1 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
2 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
3 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
4 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
5 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
6 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
7 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
8 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
9 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
10 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
11 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
12 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

13 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
15 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
16 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
17 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
18 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
20 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
21 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
22 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
23 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
24 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing

1 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers
2 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
3 license plate;

4 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
5 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
6 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.

7 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
8 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
9 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
10 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
11 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
12 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
13 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
15 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and
16 contribution of the Buffalo Soldiers. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chapter of the
18 Buffalo Soldiers 9th and 10th (Horse) Cavalry Association. As
19 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
20 deposited in the Buffalo Soldier License Plate Revolving Fund
21 created in Section 1104.16 of this title;

22 44. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates
23 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
24 for vision screening of school age children in this state. The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with Prevent
2 Blindness Oklahoma. As provided in this section, an amount of the
3 fee collected shall be deposited in the Prevent Blindness Oklahoma

6 45. Oklahoma State Capitol Restoration License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

18 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission

21 develop marketable uses for the harvested trees. The license plate

9 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
10 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.
11 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
13 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

14 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
15 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
16 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
18 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
19 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
20 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
21 title;

22 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
23 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
24 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Hospice and Palliative Care Association. As provided in this
3 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
4 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in
5 Section 1104.21 of this title;

6 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
7 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
8 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
9 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
10 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
11 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
12 collected shall be deposited in the Juvenile Diabetes Research
13 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.22 of this
14 title;

15 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
16 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
17 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Deer Creek Schools Foundation.
19 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
20 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
21 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount
22 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Deer Creek Schools
23 Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.23
24 of this title;

1 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
2 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
3 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
4 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
5 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
6 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
7 in Section 1104.24 of this title. Subject to the provisions of
8 subsection A of this section, the Lupus Awareness and Education
9 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

10 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
11 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
12 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for a vehicle or motorcycle
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
14 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of
16 Police. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design
17 as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
18 requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The Tax Commission
19 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
20 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees
21 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
23 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police of not more than Twenty
24 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the

provisions of subsection A of this section, the Chiefs of Police License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

55. Hilldale Education Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Hilldale Education Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of the Hilldale Education Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Hilldale Education Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the foundation's logo or design. 15 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
16 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
17 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
18 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
19 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 63. Collinsville Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
22 demonstrate support for the Collinsville Cardinals, and shall be
23 designed in consultation with representatives of Collinsville
24 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any

1 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
2 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
3 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
4 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
5 Oklahoma Statutes;

6 64. Sperry Pirates Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
8 for the Sperry Pirates, and shall be designed in consultation with
9 representatives of Sperry Schools. The plates shall be issued to
10 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
11 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
12 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
13 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
14 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 65. Skiatook Bulldogs Supporter License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support for the Skiatook Bulldogs, and shall be designed in
18 consultation with representatives of Skiatook Schools. The plates
19 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
20 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
21 plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in
23 Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 66. Rejoice Christian Eagles Supporter License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Rejoice Christian Eagles, and shall be
4 designed in consultation with representatives of Rejoice Christian
5 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
6 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
7 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
8 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
9 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
10 Oklahoma Statutes;

11 67. East Central Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the East Central Cardinals, and shall be
14 designed in consultation with representatives of East Central
15 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
17 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
18 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
19 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes;

21 68. Southeast Spartans Supporter License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Southeast Spartans, and shall be designed in
24 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association. The

1 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
2 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
3 license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund
5 created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 69. Sooner State ABATE License Plate - such plates shall be
7 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for Sooner
8 State ABATE. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
9 with Sooner State ABATE. The plates shall be issued to any person
10 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
11 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plate for a
12 motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new design
13 in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license
14 plate. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
15 licensing agreement with Sooner State ABATE for any licensing fees,
16 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
18 Sooner State ABATE of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
19 license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of
20 this section, the Sooner State ABATE License Plate is hereby
21 reauthorized effective November 1, 2019;

22 70. Oklahoma License to Educate License Plate - subject to the
23 enactment of Senate Bill No. 15 of the 1st Session of the 56th
24 Oklahoma Legislature, such plates shall be designed and issued to

1 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma educators.
2 Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the State
3 Department of Education. As provided in this section, an amount of
4 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Teacher
5 Recruitment Revolving Fund created in Section 2 of Senate Bill No.
6 15 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature;

7 71. Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support for the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation. Such
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Foundation. As
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate
13 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.28 of this title;

14 72. The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in
17 consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The
18 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
19 licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the
20 University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which
21 may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The
22 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of
23 Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not
24 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 73. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
3 Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
6 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
7 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
8 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
9 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
10 each license plate issued;

11 74. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
13 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
15 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
16 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
17 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
18 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
19 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
20 each license plate issued;

21 75. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
24 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
2 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
3 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
4 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
5 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
6 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 76. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
10 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
11 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
12 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
13 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
14 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
15 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 77. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
17 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
18 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
19 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
21 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
23 Revolving Fund created in Section ~~5 of this act~~ 1104.28 of this
24 title;

1 78. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
4 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School
5 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
6 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
7 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
8 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
9 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
10 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; ~~and~~

11 79. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
14 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
15 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
16 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
17 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
18 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement
19 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
20 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
21 issued;

22 80. Monarch Butterfly License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the operations of the Nature Conservancy in Oklahoma. Such plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
2 Nature Conservancy. As provided in this section, an amount of the
3 fee collected shall be deposited in the Monarch Butterfly License
4 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 4 of this act;

5 81. Oklahoma Tennis Foundation License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support for the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation. The license plates
8 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
9 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
10 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
11 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
12 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
13 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
14 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 82. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
17 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
18 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
19 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
20 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
21 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
22 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
23 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
24 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 83. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
3 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
4 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license
5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women
6 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
7 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans
8 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order
9 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
10 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans
11 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
12 license plate issued; and

13 84. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and
14 Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any
15 person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs.
16 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
17 administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
18 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any
19 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo
20 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
21 FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
22 plate issued.

23 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
24 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees

1 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
2 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

3 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
4 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
5 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
6 license plate;

7 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
9 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
10 and

11 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
12 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

13 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.33 of Title 47, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
17 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Monarch Butterfly
18 license plates shall be deposited to the Monarch Butterfly License
19 Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

20 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
21 fund for the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to be designated the
22 "Monarch Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund". The Fund shall
23 consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of this
24 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the Fund are hereby

1 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
2 Conservation Commission for grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of the
3 Nature Conservancy to fund the Conservancy's operations in this
4 state. Expenditures from the Fund shall be made upon warrants
5 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
6 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
7 Services for approval and payment.

8 SECTION 11. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
