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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-527, is  
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1-527. A. Any physician who makes a diagnosis or  
22 treats a case of a sexually transmitted infection (STI), and every  
23 superintendent or manager of a hospital, dispensary or charitable or

1 penal institution in which there is a case of an STI, shall report  
2 such case immediately, in writing, ~~to~~ or electronically:

3 1. To the director or designee of the city-county health  
4 department, if in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County, who shall, in  
5 turn, report such case to the State Commissioner of Health; or

6 2. Directly to the State Commissioner of Health, ~~or the local~~  
7 ~~health officer~~ if not in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County,  
8 in the same manner as other communicable diseases are reported, in  
9 forms to be prescribed and furnished by the Commissioner.

10 B. This act shall remain in effect until such time as the State  
11 Department of Health has in place a disease-reporting process that  
12 provides for a direct report from a lab or physician's office to the  
13 local health department and is capable of connecting a lab or  
14 physician's office with local health department systems for timely  
15 data delivery and start of the disease investigation process.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019."

14 case of a sexually transmitted infection (STI), and every  
15 superintendent or manager of a hospital, dispensary or charitable or  
16 penal institution in which there is a case of an STI, shall report  
17 such case immediately, in writing, ~~to~~ or electronically:

18 1. To the director or designee of the city-county health  
19 department, if in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County, who shall, in  
20 turn, report such case to the State Commissioner of Health; or

21 2. Directly to the State Commissioner of Health, ~~or the local~~
