11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Delete the title, enacting clause and entire bill  
12 and replace with:  
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14 "An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
15 Corrections; amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 509, as  
16 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2016  
17 (57 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 509), which relates to  
penal institutions; modifying name of facility; and  
providing an effective date.

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 509, as last  
21 amended by Section 2, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2016 (57 O.S. Supp. 2018,  
22 Section 509), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 509. The Oklahoma State Penitentiary shall be located  
24 at McAlester in Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma; and the

1 Oklahoma State Reformatory shall be located at Granite in Greer  
2 County, State of Oklahoma; and the Lexington Assessment and  
3 Reception Center shall be located at Lexington in Cleveland County,  
4 State of Oklahoma; and the Jackie Brannon Correctional Center shall  
5 be located at McAlester in Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma; and  
6 the Joseph Harp Correctional Center shall be located at Lexington in  
7 Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma; and the Howard C. McLeod  
8 Correctional Center shall be located at Farris in Atoka County,  
9 State of Oklahoma; and the Mack H. Alford Correctional Center shall  
10 be located at Stringtown in Atoka County, State of Oklahoma; and the  
11 Jim E. Hamilton Correctional Center shall be located at Hodgen in  
12 LeFlore County, State of Oklahoma; and the Mabel Bassett  
13 Correctional Center shall be located at McLoud, in Pottawatomie  
14 County, State of Oklahoma; and the R.B. "Dick" Conner Correctional  
15 Center shall be located at Hominy in Osage County, State of  
16 Oklahoma; and the James Crabtree Correctional Center shall be  
17 located at Helena in Alfalfa County, State of Oklahoma; and the Jess  
18 Dunn Correctional Center shall be located at Taft in Muskogee  
19 County, State of Oklahoma; and the Northeast Oklahoma Correctional  
20 Center shall be located at Vinita in Craig County, State of  
21 Oklahoma; and the John Lilley Correctional Center shall be located  
22 at Boley in Okfuskee County, State of Oklahoma; and the William S.  
23 Key Correctional Center shall be located at Fort Supply in Woodward  
24 County, State of Oklahoma; and the Dr. Eddie Walter Warrior

1 Correctional Center shall be located at Taft in Muskogee County,  
2 State of Oklahoma; and the Clara Waters and Kate Barnard Community  
3 Corrections Centers shall be located at Oklahoma City in Oklahoma  
4 County, State of Oklahoma; and the Lawton Community Corrections  
5 Center shall be located at Lawton in Comanche County, State of  
6 Oklahoma; and the Enid Community Corrections Center shall be located  
7 at Enid in Garfield County, State of Oklahoma; and the Union City  
8 Community Corrections Center shall be located at Union City in  
9 Canadian County, State of Oklahoma; and the Charles E. "Bill"  
10 Johnson Correctional Center shall be located east of Alva in Woods  
11 County, State of Oklahoma; and the ~~Southern Oklahoma Resource Center~~  
12 Washita Valley Correctional Center shall be located at Pauls Valley  
13 in Garvin County, State of Oklahoma; and said institutions and  
14 community corrections centers are hereby established within the  
15 Department. Said Department shall be the legal successor of and,  
16 except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Corrections Act of  
17 1967, shall have the powers and duties vested by law in the Office  
18 of Management and Enterprise Services in all matters relating to  
19 penal institutions, heretofore or hereafter established by the  
20 Department, which institutions and community corrections centers  
21 shall be under the administrative direction and control of the  
22 Department.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019."

7 Said Department shall be the legal successor of and, except as  
8 otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967, shall  
9 have the powers and duties vested by law in the Office of Management  
10 and Enterprise Services in all matters relating to penal  
11 institutions, heretofore or hereafter established by the Department,  
12 which institutions and community corrections centers shall be under  
13 the administrative direction and control of the Department.

14 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
