General Description of <u>Major Differences</u> between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Modifies the definition of "threatening behavior" to include a written threat.

Removes language requiring a student who engages in threatening behavior to complete a mental health assessment or psychological evaluation at the expense of the student's parent or guardian.

Inserts language requiring a student who engages in threatening behavior to complete a behavioral threat assessment, and directs the State Department of Education to develop a behavioral threat assessment system which school districts may utilize to determine the viability of each threat and appropriate protocol for ensuring each student receives continuity of educational services.
