14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 142, Chapter 366, O.S.L.

16	follows:
17	Section 6-102. <u>A.</u> No licensee of the ABLE Commission shall:
18	1. Receive, possess or sell any alcoholic beverage except as
19	authorized by the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act and by the
20	license or permit which the licensee holds;
21	2. Employ any person under eighteen (18) years of age in the
22	selling of beer or wine or employ any person under twenty-one (21)
23	years of age in the selling of spirits. Provided:

1 a mixed beverage, beer and wine, caterer, public a. 2 event, special event, bottle club, retail wine or 3 retail beer licensee may employ servers or sales 4 clerks who are at least eighteen (18) years of age, 5 except persons under twenty-one (21) years of age may not serve in designated bar or lounge areas, and 6 7 a mixed beverage, beer and wine, caterer, public b. event, special event or bottle club licensee may 8 9 employ or hire musical bands who have musicians who 10 are under eighteen (18) years of age if each such 11 musician is either accompanied by a parent or legal 12 quardian or has on their person, to be made available 13 for inspection upon demand by any employee of the ABLE 14 Commission or law enforcement officer, a written, 15 notarized affidavit from the parent or legal guardian 16 giving the underage musician permission to perform in 17 designated bar or lounge areas; 18 3. Give any alcoholic beverage as a prize, premium or 19 consideration for any lottery, game of chance or skill or any type

20 of competition;

4. Use any of the following means or inducements to stimulate the consumption of alcoholic beverages, including but not limited to:

- a. deliver more than two drinks to one person at one
 time,
- 3 b. sell or offer to sell to any person or group of 4 persons any drinks at a price that is less than six 5 percent (6%) below the markup of the cost to the mixed beverage licensee; provided, a mixed beverage licensee 6 7 shall be permitted to offer these drink specials on any particular hour of any particular day and shall 8 9 not be required to offer these drink specials for an 10 entire calendar week or from open to close, 11 с. sell or offer to sell to any person an unlimited 12 number of drinks during any set period of time for a
 - fixed price, except at private functions not open to the public,
- d. sell or offer to sell drinks to any person or group of
 persons on any one day or portion thereof at prices
 less than those charged the general public on that
 day, except at private functions not open to the
 public,
- e. increase the volume of alcoholic beverages contained
 in a drink without increasing proportionately the
 price regularly charged for such drink during the same
 calendar week, or

f. encourage or permit, on the licensed premises, any
 game or contest which involves drinking or the
 awarding of drinks as prizes.

4 Provided, that the provisions of this paragraph shall not 5 prohibit the advertising or offering of food or entertainment in 6 licensed establishments;

7 5. Permit or allow any patron or person to exit the licensed premises with an open container of any alcoholic beverage. 8 9 Provided, this prohibition shall not be applicable to closed 10 original containers of alcoholic beverages which are carried from 11 the licensed premises of a bottle club by a patron, closed original 12 wine containers removed from the premises of restaurants, hotels and 13 motels, or to closed original containers of alcoholic beverages 14 transported to and from the place of business of a licensed caterer 15 by the caterer or an employee of the caterer;

16 6. Serve or sell alcoholic beverages with an expired license17 issued by the ABLE Commission; or

18 7. Permit any person to be drunk or intoxicated on the19 licensee's licensed premises.

B. A mixed beverage or on-premises beer and wine licensee shall
 not be deemed to have violated the provisions of paragraph 5 of
 subsection A of this section if the licensee allowed a patron to
 leave the premises with an open container of beer or wine only and:

1	1. The otherwise prohibited act was committed during the hours
2	of 8 a.m. to midnight on the day of a scheduled home football game
3	of institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
4	Education, and the establishment is located within two thousand
5	(2,000) feet of said institution; or
6	2. The licensee is participating, by municipal invitation, in a
7	municipally sanctioned and sponsored single-day art or music event
8	within that municipality's limits; provided, the municipality has
9	provided written notice of the event and a list of invited licensees
10	to the ABLE Commission at least five (5) days prior to the event.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
